



2018 bcu Coffs TRI - ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

To facilitate the running of the 2018 bcu Coffs TRI, Coffs Harbour City Council has approved the closure of some local roads on the weekend of 3 & 4 March. All affected intersections will be under traffic control and their instructions must be obeyed.

There may be short delays so please be patient as the safety of all concerned is the major priority. NSW Police and SES volunteers will also be in attendance. Village Sports looks forward to your community support towards the 2018 bcu Coffs TRI, which raises money for local charities and community groups.

The Yacht Club and Marina will be accessible all weekend via Orlando Street.

- Access to the Jetty Marina from 5.30am – 10.30am will be via Orlando St with only one lane in and out from Orlando St through to the Marina.

The Boat Ramp will be accessible all weekend (via the Harbour Dr & Edinburgh St Intersection to Nile St & via one lane in Camperdown St).

- Access to the **Deep Sea Fishing Club** will be via Orlando St into Collingwood St, left in Edinburgh St across Harbour Dr and follow the Traffic Controllers directions.

The Airport will be accessible all weekend. (On Sunday between 5.30am – 10.00am all Airport traffic will be via the Albany St/Hogbin Dr roundabout). .

Southern Cross University will be accessible all weekend via Stadium Drive.

Motorists wishing to travel between Coffs Harbour and Sawtell will be able to via Pacific Highway.

ROAD CLOSURES SATURDAY 3 MARCH:

- 7.00am to 6.30pm - Jordon Esplanade, Marina Drive RAB to Camperdown Street intersection
- 2.00pm to 4.00pm - Jordon Esplanade from Camperdown Street Intersection to the Quarry

ROAD CLOSURES SUNDAY 4 MARCH:

- 4.30am to 6.00pm - Jordan Esplanade
- 5.30am to 10.30am - Harbour Drive from Marina Drive to Salamander Street
- 5.30am to 10.30am - Hogbin Drive from the Rugby Club to Orlando Street
- Residents south of Harbour Dr and East of Hogbin Dr will exit/enter via the Edinburgh St. and Harbour Dr intersection.
- Residents on Harbour Dr wishing to leave are required to turn left out of their driveways onto the parking lane on Harbour Dr, then turn left at the first intersection and proceed to the Edinburgh St and Harbour Dr intersection.

Please remember, there will be delays at all road closures and detours, so please be patient as most of these people are volunteers.
